You will be based in a cosy winter cottage overlooking the frozen Bay of Bothnia. This is an enchanting location, with white landscapes all around! The lodge is a welcoming wooden building with a comfy lounge area and you will enjoy your meals in the lovely restaurant upstairs.

This is also an excellent location to have a Christmas break, or a New Year holiday – a festive getaway like no other! Both periods feature wonderful celebrations with Christmas and New Year feasts. Book an Aurora Hideaway dinner and enjoy a tasty three-course meal in a cosy wooden cabin, which sits on top of the frozen sea!

Included in your holiday are transfers, half board and Arctic-grade cold-weather clothing which will be yours to keep for the duration of your stay and expert guides leading the way on all activities.

Simply decide when you want to travel and for how long (we recommend a minimum stay of three nights) then match your stay to the activities listed in the 'Activities' tab. Please note that all accommodation and activities are subject to availability at the time of booking.

We are also offering the chance to extend your stay and visit the world-famous ICEHOTEL® in Kiruna. This is done by a scenic train journey even further north into Swedish Lapland before being transferred to The ICEHOTEL® for a tour and an overnight stay in either the warm or cold accommodation on offer there.

Please note: Activity schedules are subject to change. Duration of activity includes transfer times and breaks, and all distances are approximate. Some activities require a minimum number of participants to operate and are subject to availability.

<u>Husky safaris</u>: All decisions are made on the day of the safari by the lead guide as to any guest's suitability to drive their own sledge. As a general rule, those aged 15 and over are normally able to drive their own team of huskies but the guide's decision on the day will be final. On certain safaris, children under the age of 15 will either travel in a sledge driven by the guide or an accompanying adult. There is also the option to enjoy a shorter safari on a sled for 4-5 people, which will be driven by an expert guide.

<u>Snowmobile safaris</u>: The driver of a snowmobile must be 18 years old and hold a valid driving licence. Children will travel in a sled pulled by the guide's snowmobile on selected safaris where this is offered, older children may be able to travel as pillion on the snowmobile (supplements may apply) but this is at the discretion of the guide.

<u>Single snowmobiles</u>: All snowmobile safaris are based on two people sharing. If this is not possible in your party then you will be paired with someone else taking part in the activity. If you wish to guarantee your own snowmobile you must pay the single supplement - please ask our Travel Experts for a quotation.







Aurora Hideaway Dinner

If you'd like to experience an extra-special night on the sea ice, this is the perfect evening activity.

You'll be taken by snowmobile-pulled sleigh into the wilds and across the frozen sea ice, towards the glowing cabin in the distance. This is no ordinary cabin, however, as it is moved around the archipelago on skis, pulled by a snowcat. This means that it can be put in the best possible location for Aurora hunting, based on the day's

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Nestled inside, the log-burning stove will keep you nice and warm as your guide prepares a three-course dinner for you on the fire outside. You will be served a drink of your choice on arrival (either wine, beer or a hot drink, and any further drinks can be added to your room bill to be paid at checkout). The first course will be a delicious, hot soup, followed by a main course and dessert.

Between courses, be sure to pop outside and search the skies for the Northern Lights. There will also be snowshoes available for you to use if you'd like to go for a short walk close to the cabin, as your next course is prepared.

Northern Lights Snowmobile Tour

This trip combines the best of both worlds. Experience an exciting snowmobile adventure through the Arctic night, leaving the Lodge and all artificial light behind you which also increases your chance to see the Aurora! The wintry landscape will be illuminated only by your headlights reflected by the snow, and of course the moon and stars above.

Snowmobiling is the best way to travel in the snow-covered landscape of Swedish Lapland. You don't need to head far out onto the sea ice or into the forest to embrace the feeling of being in the wilderness. This Northern Lights snowmobile tour takes you to some of the best viewing locations in the area for potential Northern Lights.

You will share a snowmobile between two (if you wish you can drive your own for a supplement) as you navigate your way through the dark winter landscape accompanied by your experienced guide. The guide will frequently make short stops to tell you about the Northern Lights as a phenomenon, how it occurs, and for you to watch and have time to take your own pictures.

Anyone wishing to drive a snowmobile must be at least 18 years old and in possession of a full driving licence. Children will typically travel in a sled pulled by the guide's machine.

Husky sledding (self-drive) 1.5-hours

Husky sledding has to be one of the most popular activities in this part of the world and a huge favourite with kids and grown-ups alike. You will be taken to a local husky farm where you will meet the excited dogs and learn how to control a sled. Following your expert guide, you will ride two people per sled, with a chance to swap drivers along the way.

This activity is 1.5 hours in duration (including transfers and preparation) and promises a great time out on the snow.

Sámi reindeer experience

Your family holiday to Lapland wouldn't be complete without seeing some reindeer and during this experience, you'll get to meet and feed the animals as well as gain an authentic insight into their cultural significance.

Starting at Brändön Lodge, you will meet with Henrik Andersson, a local Sámi man who knows all about reindeer. Together, you will enjoy a short walk to the enclosure as Henrik tells you about his culture and way of life, as well as the life of these

wonderful animals.

You will meet the reindeer who will then join you in a walk into the forest towards a Sámi tent where you can enjoy a hot drink around an open fire.

You can talk more with Henrik about life in the Arctic as lunch is prepared over the fire using fresh and traditional ingredients.

Full-Day Dog Sledding Self-Drive

This tour is for adults only, so if you fancy something more active, then this full-day dog sledding tour certainly offers that.

You'll transfer to a husky farm, approximately 1 hour away, where you will be given expert guidance and tuition on how to control your team of dogs and how to drive the sled. You'll ride two people per sled, with several chances to swap

drivers along the way, travelling through snow-covered forests and frozen lakes.

The tour involves approximately 4 hours of dog sledding, with breaks along the way, covering between 30-50km, depending on conditions. The tour also includes a wilderness lunch, cooked over an open fire and you will also get to spend some time with the dogs during and after the tour; a great photo opportunity!

Please note that the price does not include the cost of the transfer – please speak to one of our Travel Experts for a full quotation.

Cross-Country Skiing

Have some family fun in the snow as you learn how to travel across the frozen wilderness just like the locals do! During this cross-country skiing activity, you'll explore the winter wonderland surroundings of Brändön Lodge and get a real back-to-nature experience of the Lappish landscape.

Your local guide will teach you all the techniques needed to use the cross-country ski equipment. Then, once you are fitted with your skis, you and

your family will follow your guide along the snowy trails.

The weather and snow conditions will determine which route you will take - either along the solid-frozen sea, through the enchanting forest or gliding across the specially-carved snowmobile tracks. You will also stop to warm up with hot drinks along the way and enjoy the peaceful surroundings.

Ice Fishing

Ice fishing is a much-loved hobby in Sweden, and taking part can be a family tradition for many. You and the children can get a feel for this pastime with this activity. You will be taken to a specially chosen fishing spot in a snowmobile-pulled sled.

Here, your guide will show you how to drill through the ice and assemble a fishing line. As you wait for a catch, you can relax with a hot drink and a sweet snack. Species that can usually be caught include perch and occasionally pike.

Hovercraft tour on the sea ice

This is a truly unique way of getting around over the frozen sea – an experience that is only available in this part of Swedish Lapland! Journeying along, you can keep an eye out for sea eagles and seals. There should be time to stop and walk a little over the sea ice, taking in your amazing surroundings.

Northern Lights Snowshoe Walk with Wilderness Dinner

Snowshoes make it very easy to walk in areas of deep snow. You and the children will greatly appreciate this when snowshoeing in search of the Northern Lights because they will help you get to less accessible wilderness areas where it is easier to spot the Aurora.

After walking through the snow-covered forest, your guide will prepare a fire and begin cooking your evening meal, as you discuss the science behind the Aurora and learn about the local area. Hot drinks will keep you nice and warm as you look to the skies in search of the Northern Lights.

Northern Lights Sled Tour

This is a fast and comfortable way to go looking for the Northern Lights. Sit back on warm reindeer pelts in a cosy sled as your guide pulls you along with their snowmobile. Moving out over the frozen sea, you will move between islands as you search for the Aurora above. You'll make a stop for warm drinks and snacks around an open fire, as you search the skies for the Aurora.

Snowmobile Forest and Nature Tour

The snow-covered forests and the frozen sea and lakes around Brändön look magical, so it is a real treat getting to explore them on snowmobiles. You will receive full instructions on how to drive the vehicles before heading off with your guide, two people per vehicle. You can also upgrade to drive one person per snowmobile. Anyone wishing to drive must be at least 18 years old and in possession of a full driving licence. Hot drinks are

included along the way.

Children will typically travel in a sled pulled by the guide's machine.

We have a two-hour tour and a longer four-hour tour which you can choose between. Stops will be made for tea and coffee along the way, with the four-hour tour also including lunch.

Snowmobile tour to the Luleå Archipelago Pack Ice

This is an exciting adventure that takes you around the islands of the Luleå Archipelago. You will have a full briefing on how to use the snowmobiles before following your guide into the beautiful landscape. You will travel two people per snowmobile with the chance to swap the roles of driver and passenger; you can also upgrade to driving one person per vehicle for an uninterrupted thrill. Anyone wishing to drive a snowmobile must

be at least 18 years old and in possession of a full driving licence.

If conditions are favourable, your destination will be the island of Brändöskär, with its quiet fishing village surrounded by stretches of incredible pack ice and snow. Along the way, you will stop for hot drinks and lunch will be cooked over an open fire, and you will snowmobile back to Brändön Lodge.

Duration: 4 hours including lunch

Nordic Winter Skills

Strap on snowshoes and get ready to learn about the wilderness like a real explorer. A guide will lead you on a three-hour adventure on the trails near Brändön Lodge. They will point out the tracks of animals and teach you about the fauna and flora that can be found here. Stopping along the way, you will be taught how to start a small fire and rustle up a hot drink in the outdoors. For lunch, you will sit in a native-style tent for a traditional meal cooked up over a fire. This is a wonderful way to get familiar with your surroundings.

Arctic Astronomy

After an early dinner at Brändön Lodge, you will have a short transfer to the nearby home of Ulf Jonsson, an amateur consultant of aviation, space and photography who has built his own small, but fantastic, observatory.

Ulf will take you through the range of binoculars and telescopes on offer. Then, the roll-away roof will reveal the night sky and you'll get a brilliant view of the wonders overhead.

Ulf will point out constellations and explain how different cultures perceive the stars. If the moon is visible, you can track along the surface to observe the craters and mountain ranges. Of course, the real highlight in this part of the world is the Northern Lights and if conditions are favourable, you may get one of the most detailed views of this wonder. Should the Auroras appear, Ulf will also help you with your camera settings to capture this special moment.

Cross-Country Ski Hire

Fatbike Hire

Fat bikes offer a great way to explore further than you may get with cross-country skis or snowshoes, whilst still being able to appreciate the peace and quiet of this winter wonderland. The fat bikes have extra-wide tyres, which provide far better grip than a traditional bike would get in the snow. This activity is not guided and therefore you must speak to the team at reception to discuss routes and conditions before you set off. Helmets will be provided.

Please ensure that you take the lodge number and your mobile phone with you and leave details of your route before departure.

Snowshoe Hire

Hire snowshoes to explore the trails independently as a family and at your own pace. This is a great way to spend some free time enjoying the peace and quiet of your wintery surroundings. You should always consult the lodge regarding trail conditions, maps and the weather before you leave.

Included Accommodation

Brändön Lodge (Nights: 1-3)



Brändön Lodge is located on the edge of the frozen sea and looks out towards the icelocked islands of the Luleå Archipelago which sit waiting for the thaw.

This is a wonderful accommodation option for families with its combination of cosy cabins, scenic surrounding wilderness and plentiful opportunities for adventure.



Hotel facilities

- The lodge consists of a central restaurant and reception building with 15 detached cabins situated within five minutes' walk from the main building
- You will have your breakfast and evening meal in the main restaurant where you
 will also find the lodge reception area. Here you can take in the cosy atmosphere
 whilst enjoying your evening meal. The food here is typically two courses and
 served as a buffet in the evenings. You will get to enjoy some local foods, as well as
 more international dishes during your stay
- There is also a sauna and hot tub available for guests to use which is located in a separate building a short walk from the main lodge (fees apply).

The cabins

The cabins provide the perfect family base and each consists of a living area, kitchenette, en-suite shower room, toilet and two bedrooms (both with twin beds). Each cabin also has a small porch that looks out across the frozen sea.

Holiday group size (approximate)
